

Town of New Hope Regular Board Meeting
Wednesday, January 18, 2017 – 7:00 p.m.
North New Hope Church

1. Call to order.

Dan Zaborowski called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He opened the meeting leading us in the pledge of allegiance.

2. Review/Approval of minutes.
