# 5. Road Improvement report.

Dan Zaborowski said there are still concerns with beaver causing damage on Johnson Road. Trout Creek Road and Hotvedt Road have some bad areas. The total estimate from Scotts Construction for seal coating was approximately \$51,970. It was determined to postpone seal coating on some of the roads. Approximately \$21,453 of seal coating will be completed on Hotvedt Road and Grayson Road. The trip program was discussed and it was determined to decline the funding. Approximately \$10,000 in wedging will be completed this year.
