

**RESOLUTION #2019-01
ADOPTING THE PORTAGE COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS, the Town of New Hope recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, under taking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, all hazard mitigation plans are required to be updated every 5-years; and

WHEREAS, the Town of New Hope adopted the original 5-year All Hazards Mitigation Plan on December 18, 2019 and

WHEREAS, the Town of New Hope participated jointly in the planning process with Portage County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an update to the All Hazards Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of New Hope, hereby adopts the Portage County All Hazards Mitigation Plan Update as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Portage County Emergency Management will submit, on behalf of the Town of New Hope, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan Update to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval.
