

Town of New Hope Annual Meeting
Tuesday, April 16, 2019
North New Hope Church, 845 County T N, Amherst Junction

The annual meeting of the Town of New Hope was called to order by Dan Zaborowski on April 16, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at North New Hope Church. Dan opened the meeting leading us in the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the last annual meeting were read by Clerk Kari Yenter. Dean Onan moved to approve the minutes of the last annual meeting, seconded by Ramona Romundson. Ayes – all. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Clerk Kari Yenter read the financial statement for 2018.

Pat Onan asked what is included in the Town Hall expenses.

Dan Zaborowski replied electricity, phone bill and rental of the church.

Janie Miller asked what is cost to use the church.

Timm Raddatz replied it is a donation of \$300 per year.

Paul Onan moved to approve the 2018 Town of New Hope Financial Report, seconded by George Krubsack. Ayes – all. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Dan Zaborowski stated the Town of New Hope road inspections are scheduled for Saturday, April 20, 2019. He noted the fire department meets four times per year and the fire truck loan is paid off from approximately five years ago.

Dean Onan asked if the fire department charges property owners for calls.

Dan Zaborowski replied the Town bills the property owners. He said the brushing is almost completed.

Tom Weaver said new road signs are needed on Roe Lane and Grayson Road.

Dan Zaborowski said they will be taken care of.

Dean Onan moved to approve an increase to \$50 per diem for the Town Board, seconded by George Krubsack. Ayes – all. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Al Suehring moved to adjourn the annual meeting at 6:50 p.m., seconded by Janie Miller. Ayes -all. Nays – none. Motion carried.

A celebration took place immediately after the annual meeting in honor of Dan Zaborowski for his 44 years of service as Chairman for the Town of New Hope. Dan was presented with a plaque and cake.
