

**Town of New Hope Regular Board Meeting**  
**Wednesday, June 17, 2020 – 7:00 p.m.**  
**Town Hall, 9785 Town Hall Road**

**1. Call to order.**

Chairman Knepfel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He opened the meeting leading us in the pledge of allegiance.

A bill in the amount of \$13,780 was received from Swenson Tree Services for brush and tree trimming. Cars are parking on both sides of Sunset Lake Road making it difficult for vehicles to get through.

Supervisor Raddatz will contact Wellers about our recycling event. Some changes will be made this year. The recycling event will be held on Saturday, October 17, 2020.

**6. Town board action plan survey results.**

Chairman Knepfel reviewed the top results of the survey as 1) road maintenance, 2) garbage collection, 3) fire truck and 4) reserve. Chairman Knepfel contacted Harter's Fox Valley Disposal for estimates. The cost would be approximately \$16.00 to \$17.00 per house per month. A copy of the estimate was placed on file. The Chairman will contact additional garbage collection services.
